RESOLUTION DATED SEPTEMBER 26, 2016

**RESOLUTION BY THE VILLAGE OF CLAYTON
COUNTY OF JEFFERSON**

For The Jurisdictional Transfer of NYS Route 970L to the Village of Clayton

A resolution authorizing the Jurisdictional Transfer of NYS Route 970L, S.H. 5403, Jefferson County, to the Village of Clayton upon completion of improvements to that highway.

WHEREAS, the State of New York Department of Transportation is proposing highway improvements to NYS Route 970L in the Village of Clayton as described below:

1. Highway Rehabilitation including milling and resurfacing and ADA curb ramp compliance work of NYS 970L beginning at the James Street / NYS Route 12 intersection and ending at the James Street / Mary Street intersection.
2. Full Depth Highway Reconstruction including curb, drainage and sidewalk replacement of NYS 970L beginning at the James Street / Mary Street intersection, and ending at the Webb Street / Hugunin Street intersection.
3. Highway Rehabilitation including resurfacing and ADA curb ramp compliance work of NYS 970L beginning at the Webb Street / Hugunin Street intersection and ending at the Webb Street / NYS Route 12 intersection.

WHEREAS, The Village of Clayton has indicated a desire to take over the maintenance of NYS Route 970L upon completion of the work described above.

WHEREAS, Section 10, Subdivision 32 of the New York Highway Law provides, in part, that the Commissioner of Transportation shall have power, upon the request of the municipality, to abandon by an official order an existing State Highway deemed to be no longer needed or useful to the State Highway System. Upon the filing of certified copies of such official order, the State shall cease to maintain such highway, and the rights and obligations of the State therein shall be turned over and surrendered to the municipality, and such highway shall thereafter be maintained as part of the highway or road system of such municipality.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor of the Village of Clayton is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents between the State of New York and the Village of Clayton whereby the above described highway will be accepted by the Village of Clayton,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposed transfer shall be subject to the approval of the Commissioner of Transportation and such other agencies of the State of New York as required by law,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village of Clayton therefore requests, pursuant to Highway Law, that the State of New York participate in this described abandonment of NYS 970L,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that clerk of the Village of Clayton is hereby directed to transmit five (5) certified copies of the foregoing resolution to the following address:
